Critics' choices of some other Manhattan art shows:

ARIANE LOPEZ-HUICI and MICHEL
AUDER, AC Project Room, 15 Renwick
Street, South Village (through Feb. 17). Michel Auder's 1976 video of the artist Hannah
Wilke talking on the phone and performing a
wryly narcissistic striptease captures a moment when video, feminist art and Mr.
Auder's own gentle voyeuristic style were
young. By comparison, Ariane Lopez-Huici's
recently minted video of her naked self interacting with a weight-training machine is
something of a throwback. More arresting are
her photographs of an obese naked woman
proudly and unaffectedly striking a series of
Venils-like poses (Roberta Smith).
